Golf's governing bodies, the USGA and the R&A, have drafted more than 100 proposed changes to the rules of golf as we know them. Now, this is exciting news, but let's not get carried away thinking that we might make too many changes just yet! While the amendments are expected to make the rules of golf easier to understand and easier to apply, those amendments that the USGA and the R&A might invoke, will not become effective until January 1, 2019. As such, you must still follow the current set of rules that have been in effect since the last official Rules changes which were put into effect as of January 1, 2016; that is, unless your club's set of local rules may have instituted such a change currently. In summary, know the rules, including your local rules, and play by those rules until such time as those rules are changed. Good day, and good golf.
