

## **TOMGC Rules and Greens**

## January 2022

Happy New Year! As we look forward to a great new year of golf, I thought I would try to summarize our activities for both old and new members. In order to preserve space, I'm going to attempt to cover these items using bullet points. Best wishes for the coming year of 2022!

- Wednesday tournaments will now be run by the scoring committee. We will be researching the use of Golf Genius for invitation, enrollment, and scoring.
- Monthly Saturday tournaments will continue being run by Scott McClellan.
- Know your local rules. Twin Oaks Local Rules February 2021 | Twin Oaks Mens Golf Club (tomgc.org)
- We will be moving to a single scorecard system. Only one official scorecard will be turned in. It must be signed or initialed by all of the members of that group.
- Check-in fees include your green fees, shared cart, range balls, weekly game fee, and skins game fee. Green fees are at a reduced rate with the purchase of JC Resorts card.
- All winnings are paid out in the form of a Twin Oaks gift card which can be used for golf, merchandise, food and beverage. Cards are kept in the Pro Shop at the counter.
- Player of the Year points are based upon your Wednesday winnings/points. These points are accumulated for your play from January thru September.
- The Twin Oaks Cup, like the Fed Ex Cup, is a contest between the top 8 POY finishers. The players are handicapped based on the place in which they finish. The contest is held in early October. TO Cup prizes and green fees are paid for by TOMGC.
- Proper Pace of Play is encouraged with a free round bonus card.
- Senior League match play team participation is available to TOMGC members.
- Hole-in-One Club Pre-paid hole-in-one insurance fund. Details to be announced.
- During the year there will be 9 different trophy events contested. These trophies will be awarded at the year-end banquet celebration. These trophy events are:
  - The Presidents Cup gross champion only.
  - Club Championship gross champion only.
  - Senior Club Championship (55+) gross and net champion.
  - Super Senior Club Championship (65+) gross and net champion.
  - o Player of the Year (January-September point leader) net champion.
  - Twin Oaks Cup (top 8 POY points leaders) net champion.
  - Senior League Player of the Year.
    - Only gross champions are eligible for the SCGA Tournament of Club Champions.
